Heard Mr. Sandeep Khaitan, learned RP in the above IA 23 of 2020. The above application is fled by the RP praying for the following reliefs:

- "a) Allow the present Application.
- b) To pass necessary directions based on the facts and information elaborated above and also consider exclusion of the period of "status quo" from 28.01.2020 until the finality of the issue of limitation is finally decided by the NCLAT.
- c) To pass necessary directions upon the RP of the Corporate Debtor, National Plywood Industries Ltd. to issue and make urgent payments so as to maintain the affairs of the Corporate debtor as a going concern.



- d) To pass necessary directions upon the promoters and officers of the Corporate Debtor to arrange all necessary support to RP ensuring he maintains the affairs of the corporate debtor as going concern.
- e) Ad interim orders in terms of prayers above.
- f) Costs and incidental expenses pertaining to this application be reimbursed by the said Corporate Debtor as a part of CIRP expenses.
- g) Such further or other orders as this Hon'ble Tribunal may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."
- 2. As the final order dated 26.08.2019 passed by this Tribunal was set aside by the Hon'ble Apex Court in an SLP and remitted the matter to NCLAT, which has ceased off the matter, this Tribunal is not inclined to issue any direction sought by the RP basing on the casual observations of this Tribunal with regard to "status-quo" in the Order dated 28.01.2020 as the sad observation is neither a direction nor an order to the parties to maintain status-quo.
